Sandy Roellich, LCSW, CSAC is now accepting patients for AODA assessments and treatments. SBCHC can provide court-ordered AODA assessments, however not for OWI. The department can provide treatment in OWI cases where the offender is on a Driver Safety Plan if referred by their OWI assessor. SBCHC can also see self-referred OWI clients.
