

SCHOOL ORAL HEALTH PROGRAM

Scenic Bluffs offers a School Oral Health Program to students at participating schools, <u>at no cost to you.</u> This program provides preventive dental care for students during the school day, in both the fall and spring.

What does this program provide?

- Preventive dental care, including dental sealants and fluoride varnish, from a licensed dental professional.
- Each child gets tooth brushing instructions, oral health education and a toothbrush to take home.
- Participating children will be sent home with a letter for parents describing the services provided and suggestions for further treatment, if needed.
- If additional treatment is needed, Scenic Bluffs can assist parents in getting their children a dentist appointment, if you would like.
- A follow-up visit. Scenic Bluffs will return to your school to ensure sealant placement was successful and if any additional teeth are ready to seal.

Sealant facts:



Sealants prevent 80% of cavities over 2 years in the back teeth, where 9 in 10 cavities occur.

Children without sealants have almost 3 times as many cavities in the first molars as those with sealants.
